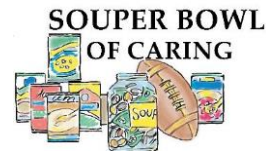
Circle one - 1st choice or 2nd choice (This can be attended more than once, as there are different speakers each year)
